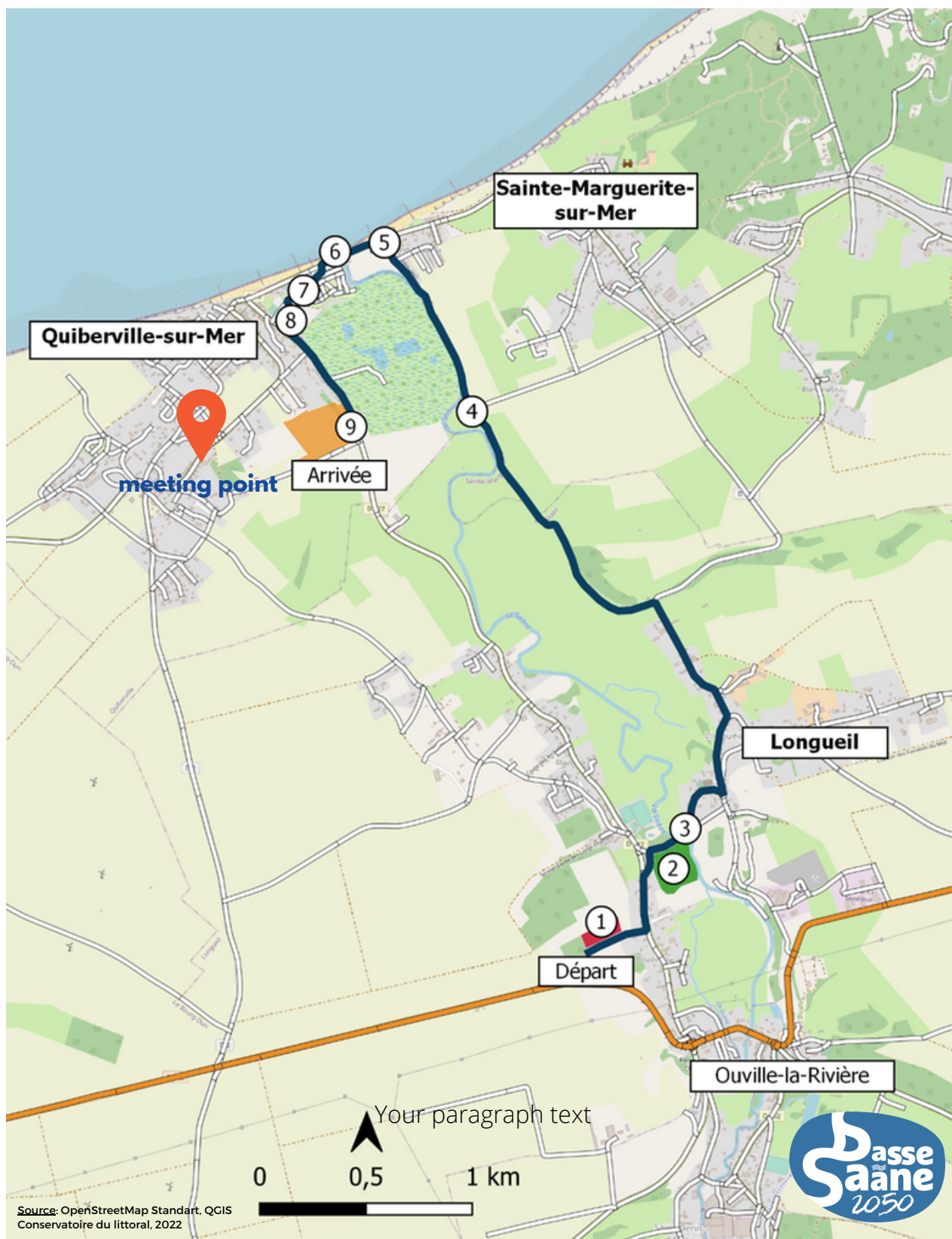

Promoting Adaptation to Changing Coasts

PACCo, Promoting Adaptation to Changing Coasts, is a cross-border project supported by the Interreg V A France (Channel) England programme.

The main objective of the PACCo project is to demonstrate that it is possible to carry out adaptation to climate change in a preventive way in estuarine areas, working with all relevant stakeholders, bringing a range of benefits to the populations of these coastal areas.

The project focuses on two pilot sites: the Lower Otter Valley, Devon, England and the Lower Saône Valley, Normandy, France.

• The lower Saône Valley

- New tourist facilities (Quiberville)
- Nature restoration of the current campsite
- New wastewater treatment plant and creation of sewage networks in Longueil



• The lower Otter Valley



- Opening of 70m in the dike (bridge)
- Creation of a bridge and raising of the road to maintain access to South Farm
- Relocation of Budleigh Salterton Cricket Club
